# Medina of Tunis

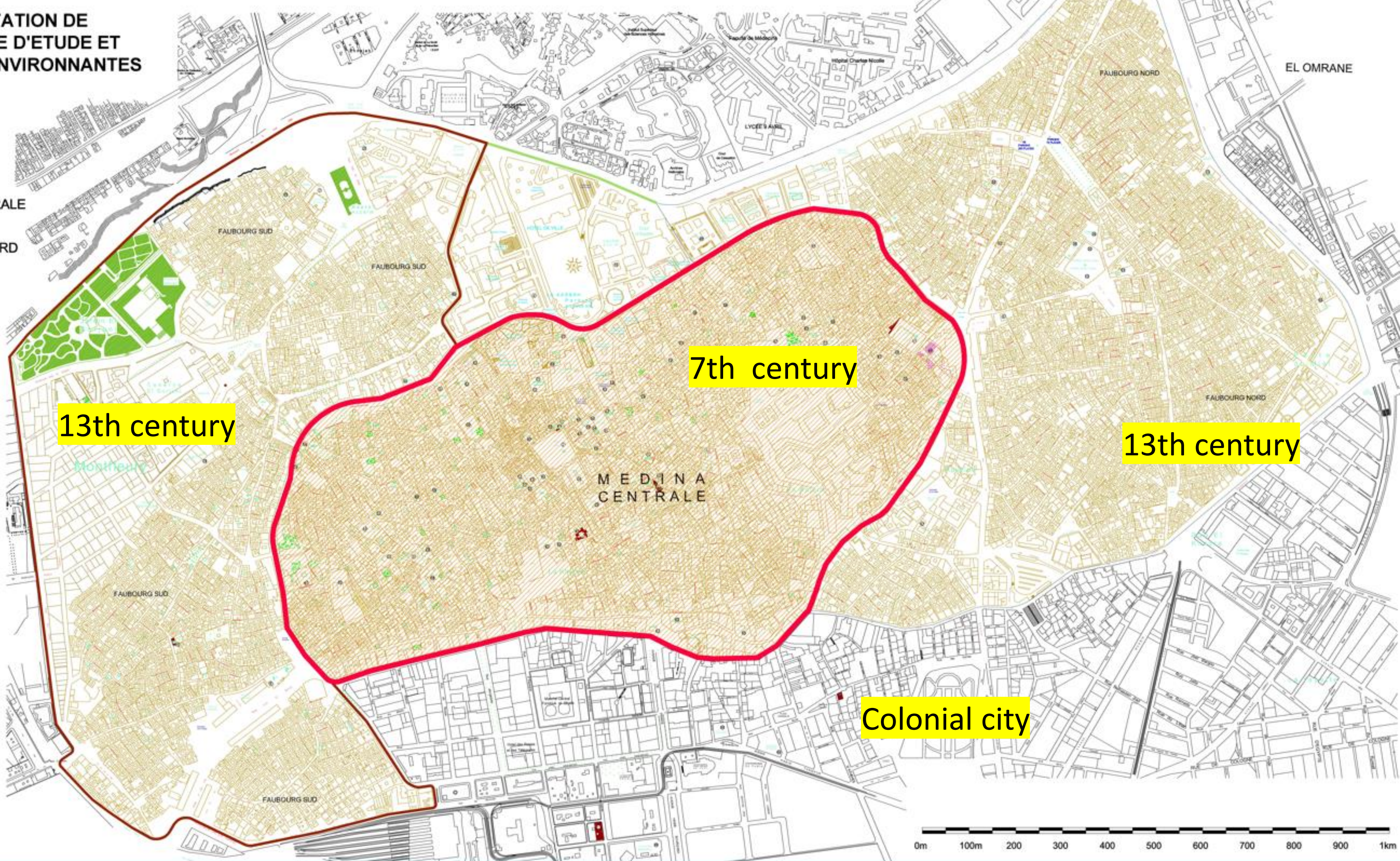
- UNESCO World Heritage site
- One of the first Arabo-Muslim towns of the Maghreb (founded in 698 A.D.)
- 700 historical monuments
- Densely populated  
*(100000 residences, 280 hectares)*
- Urban and environmental degradation
- Lack of green & safe spaces

82,4% homes occupied  
10% vacant  
2,2% abandoned

## Housing conditions

10,7% of housing in bad conditions  
(0,6% for all of Tunisia)

## Home ownership

Only 40,9% own their homes  
(lowest in the country, Bab Bhar  
area 16,2% ownership)

## Medina Poverty rate

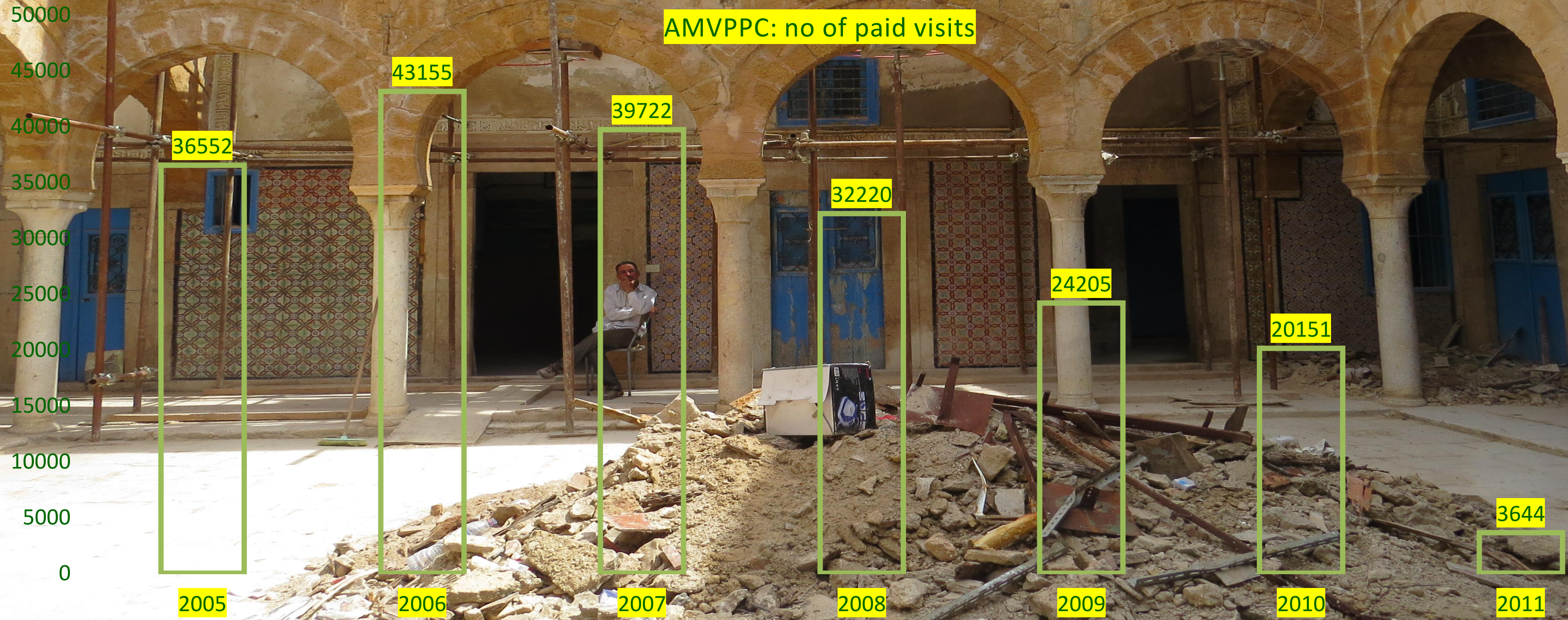

AMVPPC: no of paid visits

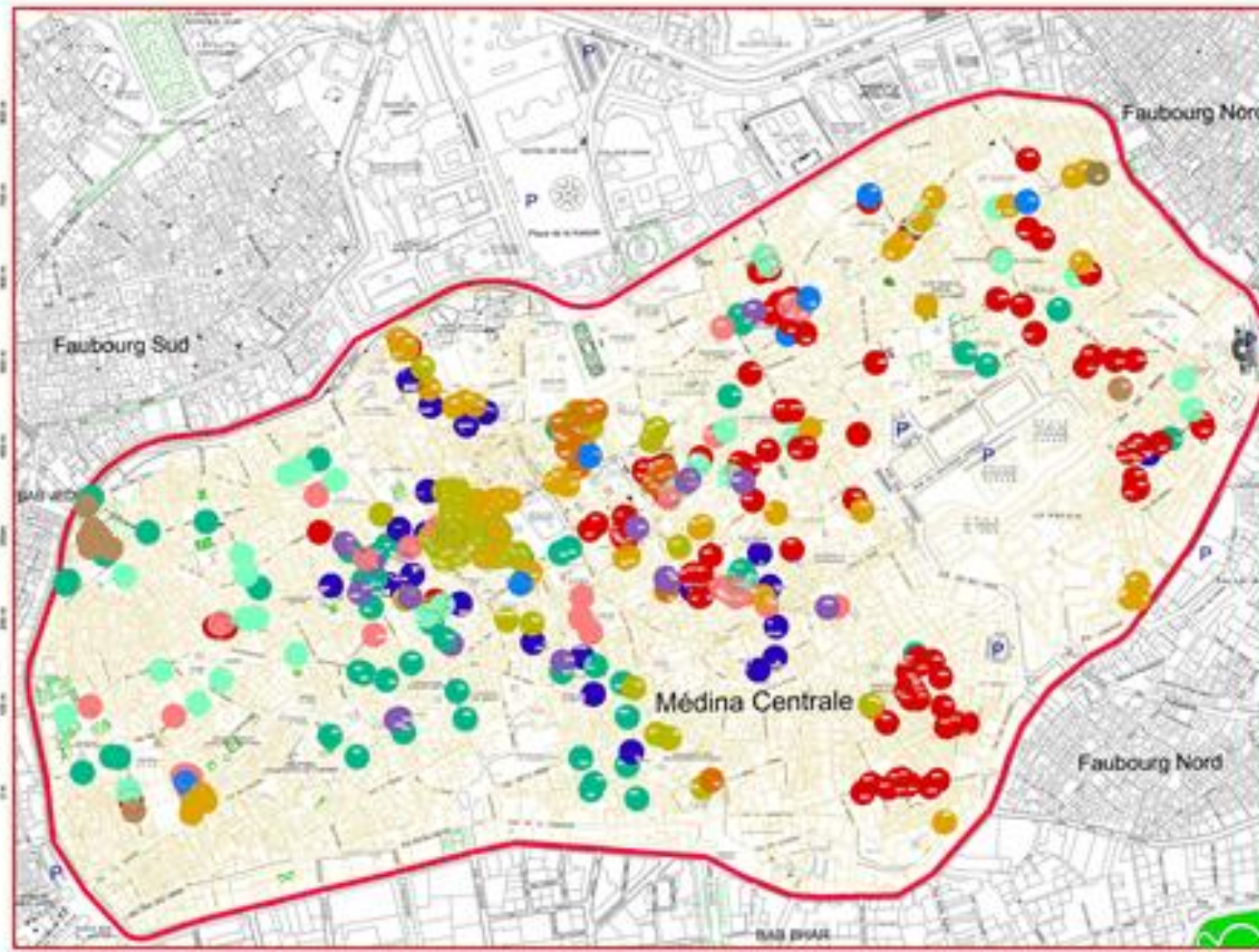
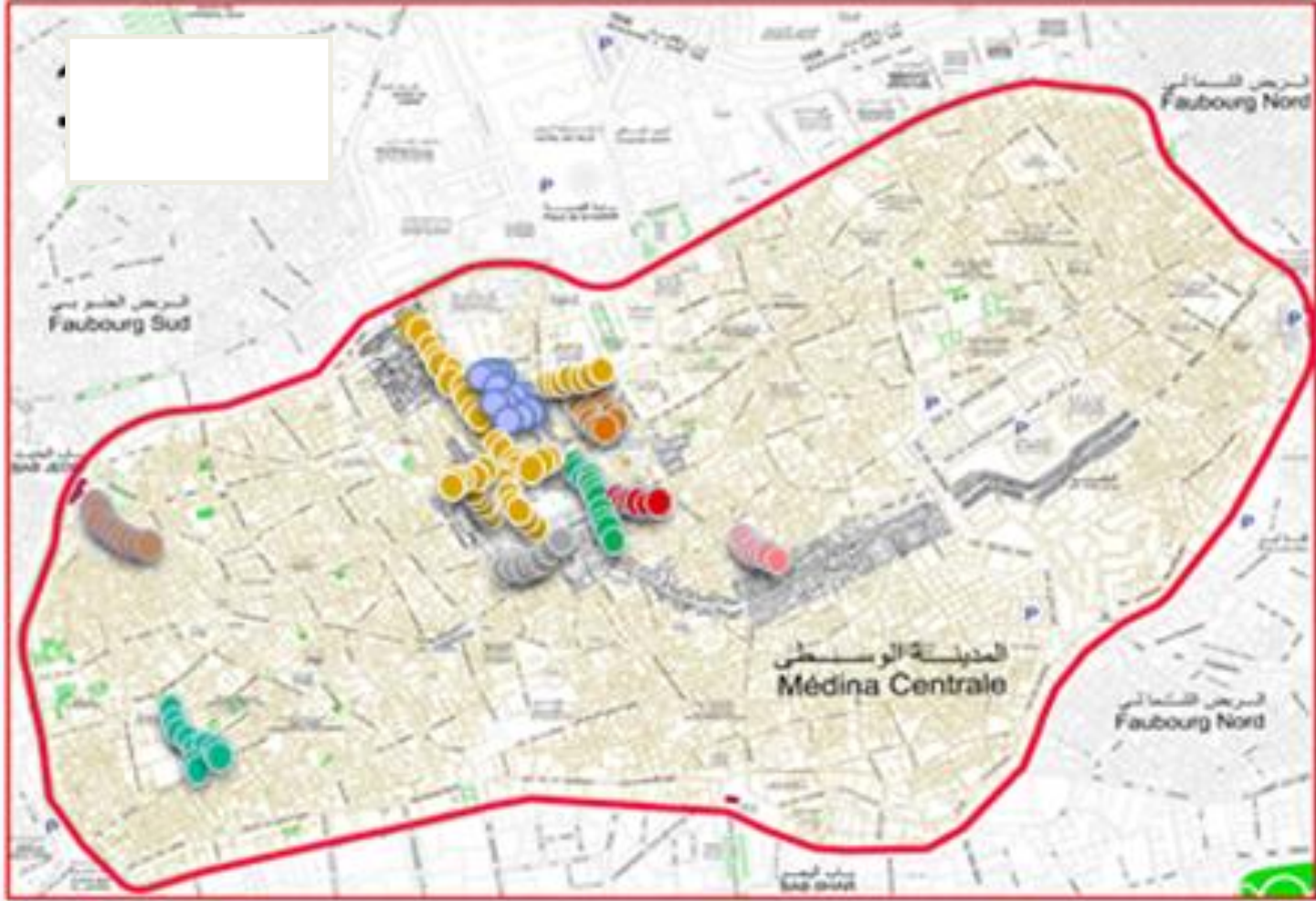




ASM's 2014 survey, 525

Medina











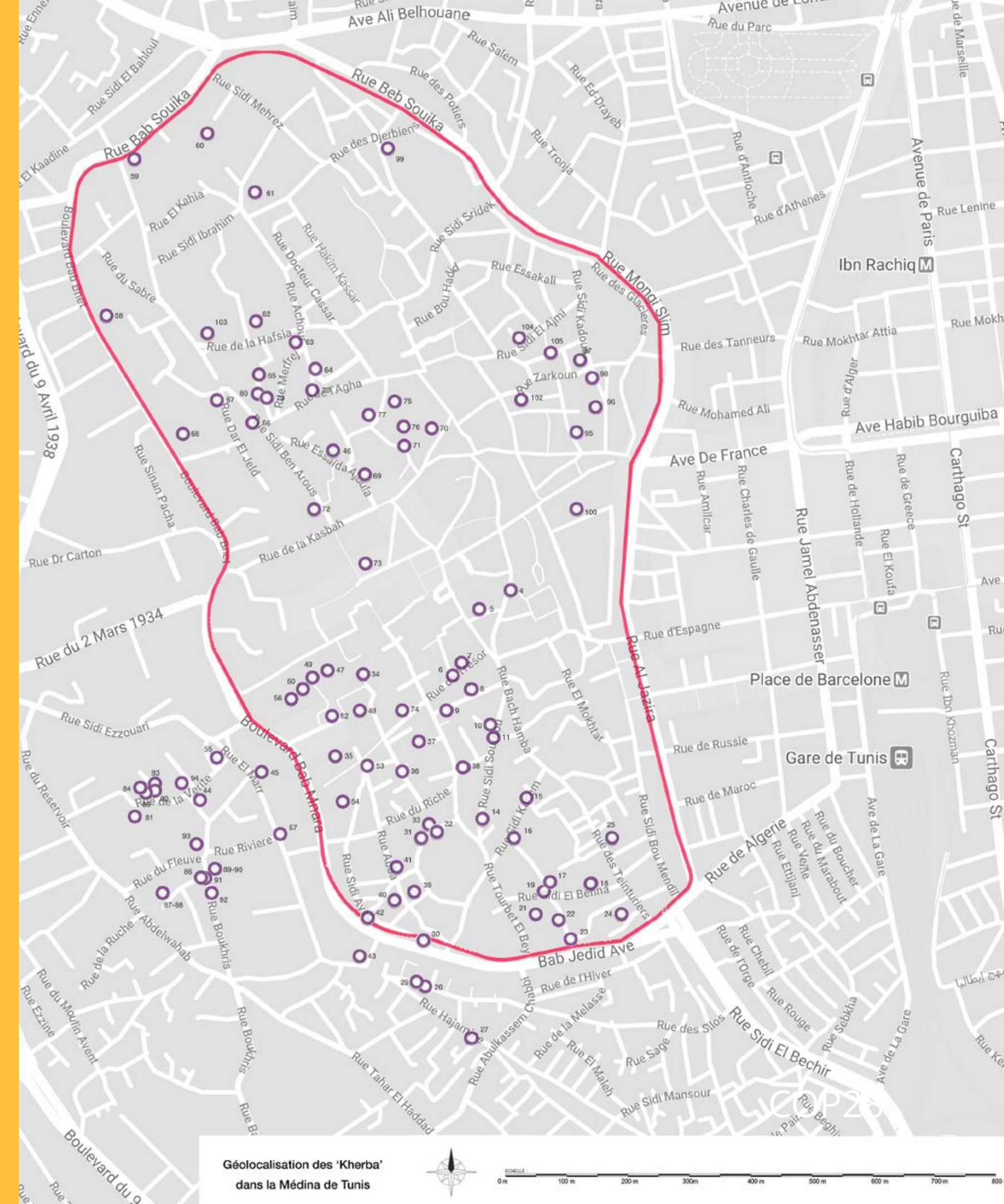
More than 50% of artisan workshops are in abandoned historical residential homes. ASM survey 2014

- 1/3 public properties





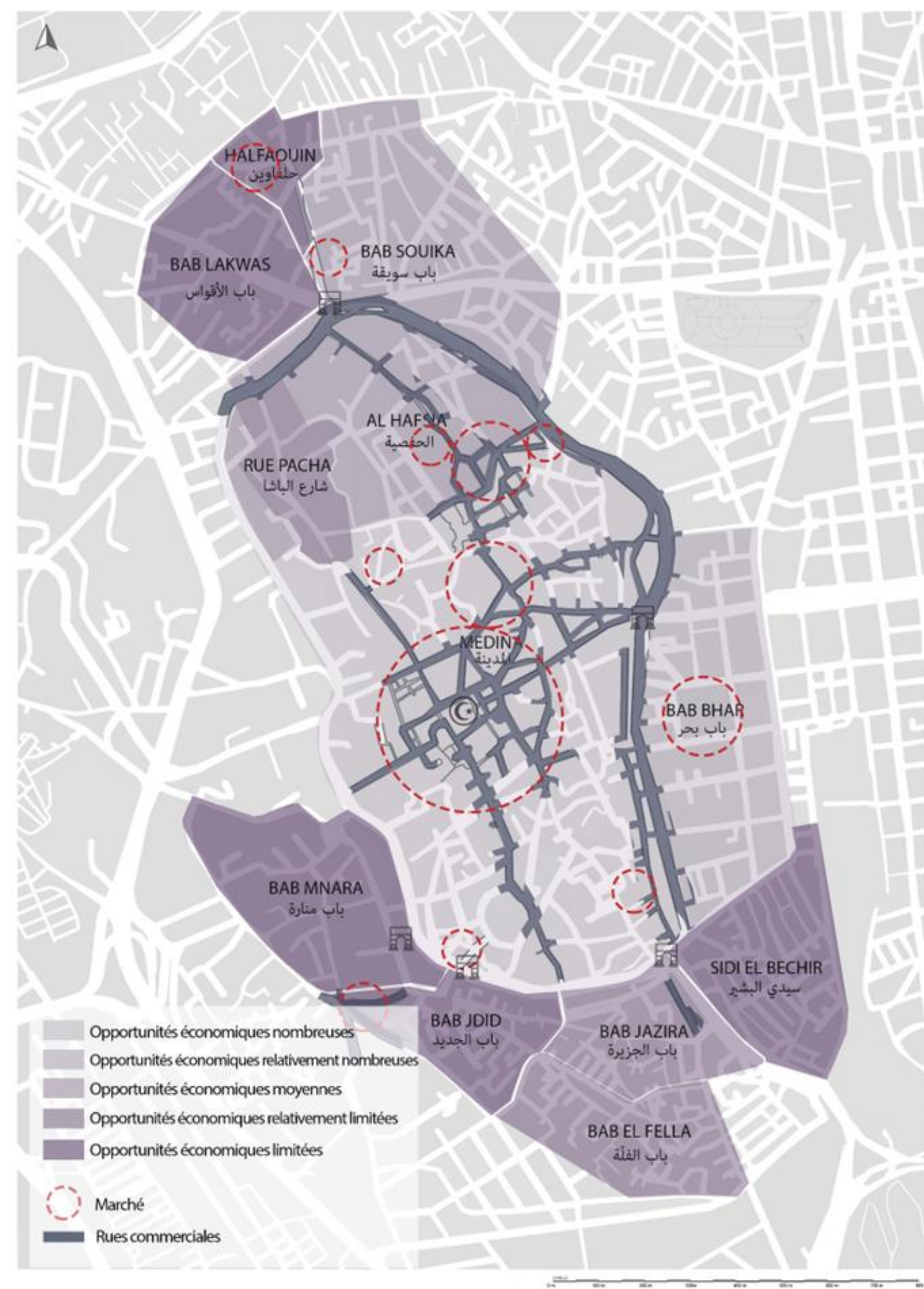

- No safe urban spaces for network, hinders social and political participation
